Wayne County Soccer Association (WCSA) is accepting registrations for the fall 2008 recreational soccer season. This is the division of WCSA that plays soccer on Sunday afternoons at the Wayne County Fairgrounds adjacent to the Kuhlman Center. We had 273 children playing last year on 28 teams.

Age

We offer 4 age divisions for children ages 5 through 13 (age as of September 1).

Season

Games are played on Sunday afternoons in September and October. Practices begin in late August. You can expect two practices per week prior to opening day and then one per week once the season begins. Practice times are at the discretion of the coach, but generally are scheduled weekdays in the late afternoon or early evening.

Philosophy

This program is intended to offer a fun physical activity for all participants. Interaction between children, team involvement, knowledge of the game and having fun is emphasized. Wins and losses are not officially recognized nor is tracking the score encouraged. This program is excellent for introducing young children to the game of soccer and for any child who wishes to participate in a recreational physical activity.

Teams

We randomly assemble teams from children registered for each age division. Each age division generally has 4-8 teams depending on the number of children registered. All teams in all age divisions are co-ed. We attempt to place a child and one friend on the same team when requested on the registration form and received together.

Coaches

We rely on parents to coach these teams. An orientation is mandatory for all coaches and assistance from WCSA representatives is available at any time. WCSA has Richmond High School coaches on its Board of Directors, Earlham College coaches available for assistance, and members with many years of soccer involvement.

Involvement

This program is run by parents. However, parents leave the program as their children move on and must be replaced. Anyone with an interest to see soccer continue in our community is encouraged to get involved. Please contact any Board member (www.waynecosoccer.com) and ask how you can help. If you are interested in serving on the Recreational Soccer Committee we can always use more help!

Travel Teams

WCSA also offers a more competitive level of play. We organize travel teams every spring and fall for children ages 8-19. This level is a separate division and involves play against teams from other soccer clubs throughout central Indiana.
